Types of Abuse

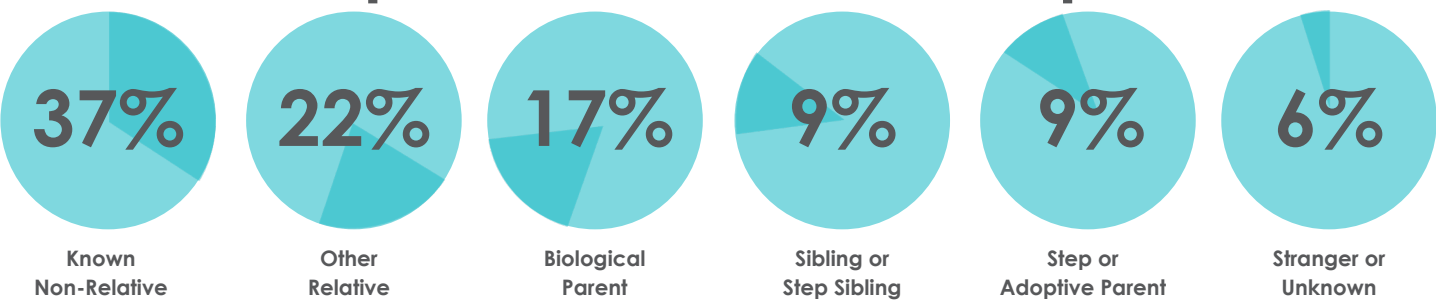


Gender

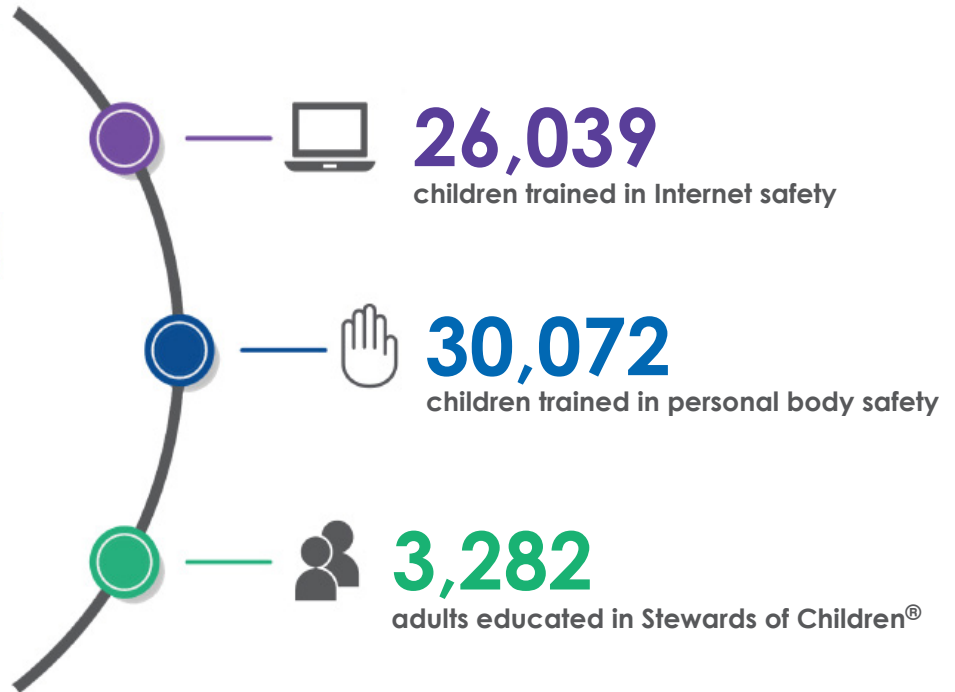
